The Board of Supervisors met this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 2021, at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Richard Crouch, Carol Vinton, and Lonnie Mayberry all present.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Vinton to approve Consent Agenda and minutes from September 14<sup>th</sup> as presented. There were liquor license renewals for Tobey Jack's for a Class C with outdoor service for a 5-day service. The Back Room Lounge Class C for outdoor service and Sunday Sales. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Supervisor Crouch updated on the tour he was on with RC&D projects and also read a letter requesting the County, City & School go together and paint the railroad overpass coming into Glenwood. However, this is railroad property and access to do this is hard to get.

Mills County Engineer, Jacob Ferro was present for the next items on the agenda. There were no utility permit reports.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Vinton to approve Matt McManigal for the bridge foreman position. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0 McManigal started September 15, 2021 at \$27.75/hour. This will be a promotion for McManigal.

Pease Road repairs was tabled for further information.

Ferro reported that we will receive a report after two weeks of the sign's recording of the speeds on 229th Street and times that are recorded.

Motion by Vinton, seconded by Mayberry to approve Lori Swisher as part-time clerk for VA. Swisher brings 13 years of service and experience. September 15<sup>th</sup> was her start date and comes to the County accredited. She will work 20 hrs/week regular hours at \$15.00/hour. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Sheriff Travis Oetter joined the session to request approval of pay increase for Evan Ruse for completing his six-month probationary period. Russ's salary will increase from \$54,542.00 to \$58,272.00 effective October 8, 2021. Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Vinton to approve increase. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Options for pipeline requirements were discussed by the Board. There were concerns of the County having to come up with funds to pay and then request funds for repayment.

Board of Supervisors met as Canvass Board for September 14, 2021 Special Election. The results of East Mills School Proposition-L Yes 675, No 385. The results of East Mills School Proposition-M Yes 666, No 401. Proposition L passed 63.86%; Proposition M passed 62.42%. Motion by Vinton, seconded by Mayberry to approve the Canvass of the East Mills Special School Election. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

The Board will be leaving to attend the 4-County meeting being hosted by Page County in Clarinda.

There being no further business to come before the Board, they adjourned to meet on October 5, 2021.
