The Board of Supervisors met this 25th day of October 2022, at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Lonnie Mayberry, Carol Vinton and Richard Crouch were present.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry to approve the consent Agenda and Minutes as presented and Accounts Payable as received from October 18, 2022. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Jacob Ferro, Mills County Engineer, was present for his scheduled meeting. Ferro informed the Board on current Utility Reports: Fiber 400', 23134 Norris Ave, Tele Com; Fiber 960', 22871 Kane Ave, Tele Com; Fiber 960', 23615 Kane Ave, Tele Com; Fiber 915', 61410 245th Ave, Tele Com.

Ferro updated the Board on various areas in his departments. He has interviewed a possible candidate for Engineering Tech. Susan Weigel, 911/Communications Director will be helping with programming of radios to communicate with the older type radios which some of the crew are still using.

Lorri Greiner, Public Health, was present for her scheduled meeting. Darcy Butts and Matt Woods were present as representatives of the Public Health Board. They currently have interviews set up for next week for the Administration position. They also have a possible candidate for the nursing position.

Travis Oetter, Sheriff, was present for his scheduled meeting. Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch on Approval to a pay increase beginning October 25th for Deputy John Spanagle per Union Contract from \$61,170 to \$63,005. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry to Approve rehiring of Sabrina Johnson as Office Manager beginning November 7 with a salary of \$53,803. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch on Approval to a pay increase beginning October 9th for Detention Officer Michelle Starner per Union Contract from \$43,219 to \$44,518. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch on Approval to a pay increase beginning October 9th for Detention Officer Claire O'Donnel per Union Contract from \$43,219 to \$44,518. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0.

Holly Jackson, Building and Zoning, was present for her scheduled meeting. Jackson updated the Board on the possibility of working with a consulting firm for information on Utility Solar Ordinance. Approval to work with a Consulting Firm was tabled until November 1st.

Patrick Binns, IT Department Director, was present for his scheduled meeting. Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry on Approval of Construction Documents Contract with KPE Architecture in the amount of \$42,500. Breakdown is: \$36,000 Architectural Structure Plans; \$3,500 Civil Engineering; \$3,000 Survey. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

The Board discussed the position of the County Attorney vacancy at length. They will continue these discussions in the upcoming weeks of possible changes allowed per Iowa Code.

There being no further business to come before the Board, they adjourned to meet on November 1, 2022.
