Indian Creek Greenbelt

60220 410th St Emerson, IA (½ mile south of Emerson on 410th St, south of RR tracks)





This 17-acre park along Indian Creek is composed of restored prairie and riparian area. Obtained through a federal flood buyout, the site currently offers creek access as well as a mowed trail around the restored prairie and a sizable green area for picnicking. Great place for bird watching with the combination of habitats. Fruit trees have been planted on this site for public use.

This park is open to non-consumptive recreational use. It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy, or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.

Please read over these basic rules for the park:

- No motorized vehicles beyond the parking area
- No hunting or trapping
- No firearms
- No camping
- No open fires
- No fireworks
- Pets must remain on a leash at all times
