Mills County Public Health has current openings for a vaccine clinic starting at 10am on Wednesday, April 7, 2021. If you are 18 or older, you qualify for the vaccine – there are no health conditions, no parameters on profession, and no other special requirements. The vaccine is the best tool we have in our fight against the virus. If you live or work in Mills County, now is the time and vaccine is available through Mills County Public Health, HyVee Pharmacy in Glenwood, and Kohll's Pharmacy in Malvern.
