ZERO NEW CASES OF COVID-19 REPORTED

Mills County Public Health reported no new cases of COVID-19 as of Tuesday, June 1, 2021. This is the first week without any new infections in well over a year. County public health officials are pleased with the containment of the virus. “Cases rose sharply just prior to Thanksgiving last year, with a record 220 positive cases in Mills County, in a one week reporting period.” According to Public Health Administrator Julie Lynes, “It is a monumental relief to be on this side of the pandemic. We urge anyone who has not yet received the vaccine to schedule an appointment now. Our goal is to get the vaccine to 100% of our community so everyone is protected.”

Vaccines are readily available at the Mills County Public Health Office, HyVee and Medicap Pharmacies in Glenwood, and Kohll’s Pharmacy in Malvern. Appointments are available online and walk-ins are welcomed. Call 712-527-9699 for more information.
